Getting Started

Joining a new online group can be a little intimidating at first, but here are some tips for how you can get involved and become a valuable member.

- ◆ **Explore.** Plan to spend at least 15-30 minutes exploring the discussions that have already taken place or are in progress.
- ◆ **Create a new post.** A quick introduction makes a great first post. It lets the group know that a new member has joined and it lets you see how the system works and what happens when you create a new post.
- ◆ **Reply to an existing post.** Find a topic or discussion and post a reply. Even if you are just agreeing with something that someone else said, it's good practice and lets the group know you are willing to participate.
- ◆ **Stay involved.** There are a number of ways to monitor and stay in touch with the group. Pick the option that works best for you and make sure you stay connected.
- ◆ **Explore—again!** There are many amazing opportunities that the Corrections Community has to offer. A variety of news columns (blogs) offer great information about what's happening in Corrections and there are a number of public forums that you can also use.

* Please don't write down your password if you also use the same password at work or other private accounts. Instead, you could just write in a hint like, "Same as work" to remind you what your password is.
