Roadmap to Reentry is a twelve week curriculum based on the principle that learning does not have to be painful in order to be effective. Exercises are designed to deliver an "Aha" effect in similar situations outside the classroom environment. There are no right or wrong answers. Everyone's opinion is valid.
